Today we will be taking up the monthly offering for the Singh Family. Offerings can also be given at any time with the notation "Operation Singh". Thank you!

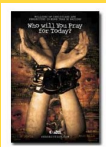


Mountain Movers Prayer Meeting TUESDAY Noon—2 PM

We are honored you joined us this morning. As you worship with us, you will be warmly greeted by our fellowship, have an opportunity to encounter God, and be encouraged through the teaching of the Word. We value being a family of believers who love one another, gather together to encounter the presence of God, and believe we have been commissioned to extend the Kingdom of God on earth as it is in heaven.

Service Format...What you should expect

10:00 - Our services begin with a time of Praise, Worship, and Spiritual Gifts. During this time, we encourage all biblical expressions of praise and worship, such as clapping, lifting of hands, shouting, dancing, and bowing. Such biblical expressions usher in the presence of God which is commonly marked by the release of various spiritual gifts. All are encouraged to participate in this portion of our service. Please see 1 Corinthians 11 - 14 for more explanation.

10:30 - Children are dismissed to classes while worship continues.

11:00 - Communion, Welcome, Announcements, Offering

11:15 - The ministry of the Word. This is a time of teaching and preaching from the Bible. We encourage everyone to bring a Bible and to take notes. Audios of the messages are available on the church website.

12:00 - Dismissal

A nursery for infants 6 weeks through age two is located in the last room on your right as you enter the building.

Dismissal at 10:30

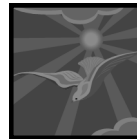
Preteen Discipleship (5th-7th grade)

The overhead screen will signal the dismissal times. At this point, all children can proceed to class. Teachers will meet the children at the back of the sanctuary to escort them.

Please Remember:

- ~ Turn off cell phones when you enter the sanctuary.
- ~ No food is allowed in the sanctuary.
- ~ Please have ONLY liquids that are in SPILL-PROOF cups or bottles.
- ~ Please reserve the last two rows for families with small children.
- ~ Parents, please accompany children up front during worship time.
- ~ Please use the nursery for young crying children during communion.
- ~ All children under the age of 13 must be supervised on the CCC playground at all times.
- ~ Children under the age of 16 must be accompanied by an adult in the parking lot.
