

WHAT ARE TITHES AND OFFERINGS?

- 1. Tithing is the practice of giving one tenth of one's increase to the Lord (to be used for His work). Ge 14:20; Lev 27:30; Dt 14:28-29
- 2. Offerings are voluntary gifts given to the Lord's servants or for special purposes. Ex 25:2–7; 29:27–28; Lev 9:22; Nu 5:9

SHOULD I TITHE AND HOW MUCH SHOULD I GIVE?

- 1. Tithes and offerings support those who work as ministers to the Lord. 1 Co 9:7-11; He 7:1-21
- 2. We believe that Christians should seek the Lord on how much to give to His work, but not give less than ten percent. 2 Co 9:7
- 3. Believers should give proportionately and regularly. 1 Co 16:1-2; 2 Co 9:6; 8:14-15

WHAT ARE SOME BENEFITS OF TITHING AND GIVING?

- 1. They help us overcome selfish tendencies and desires to steal from others. Ep 4:27-28; 1 Tim 6:6-10
- 2. Although God is not obligated to give money in return for our giving, there is a valid principle of sowing and reaping. Lk 6:38; 2 Co 9:6-9
